COURSE OVERVIEW

The Diploma in Advanced Psychotherapeutic Practice is designed for qualified counsellors to build on their core training and deepen their practice in a number of areas:

- working with complex client presentations
- working at depth within the therapeutic relationship
- developing skills in appropriate client assessment and working ethically and safely with risk
- heuristic research in counselling

This level 6 qualification meets the training competences aligned with SCoPEd Column B. Successful completion of the course means that you will be able to work confidently in a range of settings including private practice or as a senior counsellor in a counselling agency.

WHAT DOES THE COURSE INVOLVE?

- Attending the training session every fortnight
- Attending tutorials with a personal tutor
- Reading books from the required & recommended reading lists
- Completion of a substantial portfolio of written work including written assignments and a clinical case study
- Group and peer supervision
- Group work, presentations, and reflective exercises
- Completion of a short, observational placement in a mental health setting (1-2 days)
- Clinical assessment experience (4-6hrs)
- Completion of a minimum 50 hours of supervised clinical practice
- Weekly personal therapy during the course with a minimum requirement of 35 hours
- Being assessed as proficient internally

In addition to attending the training sessions each fortnight, the course requires an additional time commitment for: clinical hours, study, reading, research, written work, mental health observational placement, clinical assessment experience, peer supervision groups and personal therapy.

COURSE FEE

The course fee is **£2650**

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

This qualification is intended for candidates who have gained counselling training qualifications up to Level 4, with a minimum of 420 Guided Learning Hours.

- Minimum age is 21 years
- Proven ability to produce written work to meet the academic requirements of this qualification level
- Robustly developed emotional resources and resilience
- Capacity and desire to proactively embrace and engage in a deep level of self-awareness and personal development
- Full completion of the course application form including pre-course essay
- Shortlisted applicants will be invited to interview

The intensity of advanced practice training means that it is not advisable for those dealing with ongoing emotional issues or enduring mental health difficulties.
